The North Dakota Benefits Center (ND BEC) is a one stop resource center designed to assist low income Medicare recipients with accessing additional benefits.

We guide the consumer through a complete benefits assessment to explore and identify your options for any current or additional qualified benefits.

What We Do

- ND BEC will provide guidance for those transitioning to Social Security and Medicare. Consumers are encouraged to contact the center with questions they may have regarding Social Security and Medicare.
- ND BEC will assist people with disabilities who are on SS Disability Income (SSDI) with Medicare applications and transitioning to the use of Medicare.
- ND BEC will assist individuals with Medicare Part D enrollment.
- ND BEC will provide ongoing support for qualified benefit programs.
