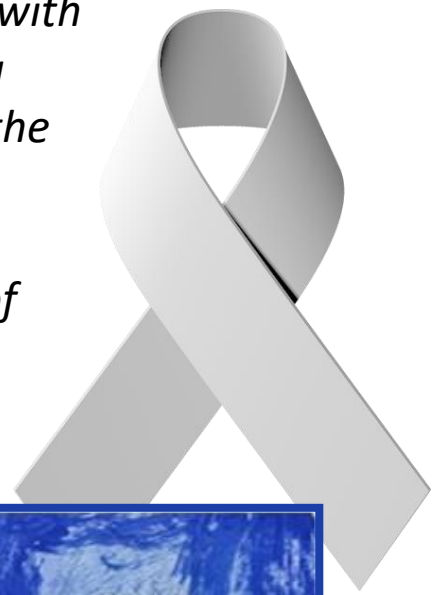


March is **Developmental Disabilities** Awareness Month
