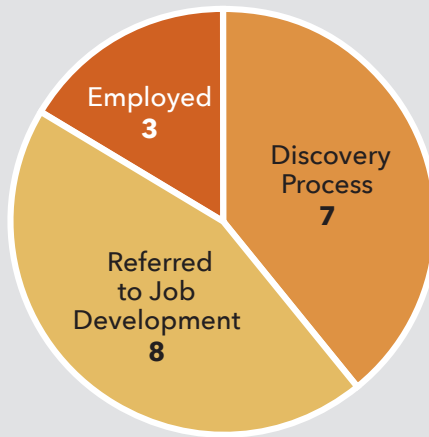

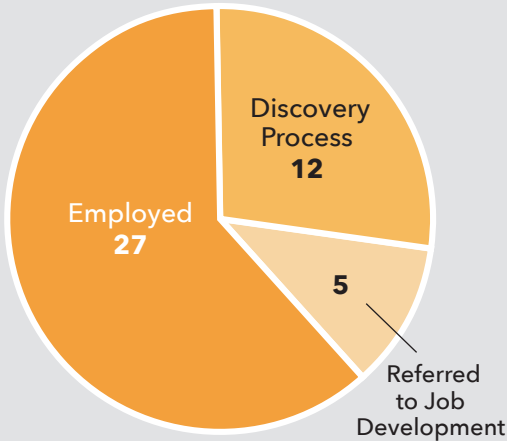
YEAR 2

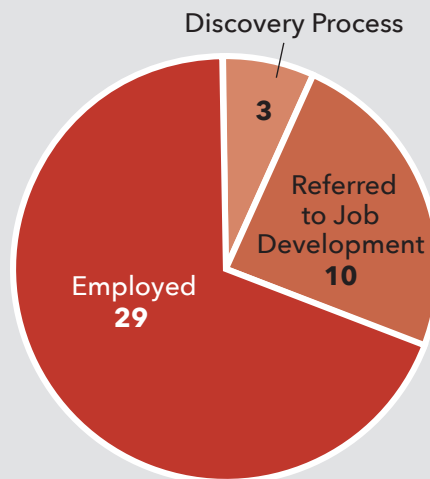
Total Number of Participants for Year 3
