ASTEP students complete a three-year program of study including inclusive core and elective courses (for credit or audit), career focused employment internships, independent living and self-determination activities, and have opportunities for social engagement.

Students work with ASTEP staff to follow their program of study to be successful in college as well as learn more about their long-term professional goals.

Upon program completion, students receive a meaningful career focused certificate. Students auditing courses receive an ASTEP College-to-Career Certificate. Students taking courses for credit earn the [DCB Technical Studies Certificate/AAS degree](#) or other [DCB at Minot certificate options](#).

ASTEP connects students to various academic supports such as academic advisors, peer supports and on-campus services which include advising, tutoring and mentoring.
