

Do you qualify for a Special Enrollment Period for health coverage?

Changes in Residency

- Moving to a new ZIP code where new QHPs are available
- Seasonal worker moving to or from the place they live and work
- Moving to or from a shelter
- A student moving to or from the place they attend school
- Moving to the U.S. from a foreign country or U.S. territory

Loss of Health Coverage

- Losing job-based health coverage
- Losing eligibility for Medicare
- Losing eligibility for Medicaid
- Losing eligibility for CHIP
- Turning 26 and losing parental coverage

New Opportunity

- Low Income at or below 150% of Federal Poverty Line

Changes in Household

- Getting married
- Getting divorced
- Having a baby
- Adopting or fostering a child
- Death in the family

Life Events

- Income changes that affect the coverage for which you qualify
- Gaining status as an American Indian or Alaska Native
- Becoming a U.S. citizen
- Leaving incarceration
- AmeriCorps members starting or ending service
